

## Differences Between Clinical Chart and Connected Care Center

The <u>CURES Act</u> requires that facilities share information with authorized individuals and extended care team partners who are responsible for the care and treatment of the resident to promote transparency and continuity of care during transitions or referrals and consultations.

Connected Care Center is a tool embedded in PointClickCare that allows individuals with resident consent, to access their resident's documentation. The Cure's Act requires that this information be shared electronically where possible and where not, through other means such as printing Clinical Chart.

However, there are differences between Clinical Chart and the Connected Care Center of which facilities and individuals should be aware.
