

Differences Between Clinical Chart and Connected Care Center

The [CURES Act](#) requires that facilities share information with authorized individuals and extended care team partners who are responsible for the care and treatment of the resident to promote transparency and continuity of care during transitions or referrals and consultations.

Connected Care Center is a tool embedded in PointClickCare that allows individuals with resident consent, to access their resident's documentation. The Cure's Act requires that this information be shared electronically where possible and where not, through other means such as printing Clinical Chart.

However, there are differences between Clinical Chart and the Connected Care Center of which facilities and individuals should be aware.

Clinical Chart	Connected Care Center
Consent – Clinical Chart can be printed to fulfill any authorized disclosure as permitted through HIPAA.	Consent – The Resident must consent to any individual accessing their documentation,
Configurable Content – the facility determines what modules and module documentation is included in Clinical Chart. Content can be configured to include or exclude modules and features within modules including struck out documentation.	Content is not Configurable – the Cures Act dictates the contents of Connected Care Center and will always show the documentation required by the rule. Content will evolve over time as per the rule. Struck out documentation will not display to prevent potential HIPAA issues. The initial iteration will include (Source in PointClickCare in brackets): <ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Allergies and Intolerances (Allergy tab) 2. Care Plan (Care Plan tab) 3. Practitioners (Medical Professionals – Profile tab) 4. Clinical Notes (Prog Notes tab) 5. Diagnoses/Conditions (Diag tab) 6. Immunizations (Immun tab) 7. Lab/Rad tests and results (Results tab) 8. Medications 9. Patient Information (Demographics) 10. Vital signs (Wts & Vitals tab) Portal will show “No Records Found” for related category if there is no documentation in PointClickCare.
Time Range Dependent – Clinical Chart is printed based on designated start and stop times selected by the person printing the document.	Shows all Chart Content – Connected Care Center will display documentation through to the day viewed. The information is not parsed by selected start and stop dates.
Printed Format – always printed PDF or viewed as a PDF.	Digital Format – Designed to be viewed electronically (portal view/API) .
Displays all Documentation Dates – shows effective, created, and revision dates and authors associated with documentation changes.	Displays Documentation Created Dates – Where dates display, it is the date and time the item was created in PointClickCare along with last revision date where appropriate.
